This notice contains a statement of the estimated revenue from property taxes and the total amount from sources other than property taxes and also contains the proposed expenditures and revenues by fund and/or line item for the Fiscal Year 2026-2027. This proposed budget may be based on preliminary tax revenue estimates received by the District from the County and is subject to adjustment at the public hearing based upon final tax revenue figures which are anticipated to be received from the County prior to the budget hearing.
